SUBJECT: Solicitation Number: 19BK8021Q0004 - QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

The Embassy of the United States of America in Bosnia and Herzegovina received the questions below on the subject solicitation which was posted on January 29, 2021.

1 QUESTION: Shall the Government mark proposal as “unacceptable” and exclude from further evaluation if a bidder/offeror fails to provide all documents required by FAR 52.212-3 paragraph (h)?

ANSWER: Prospective bidders/offerors shall provide information required by FAR 52.212-3(h) for the contracts whose value is expected to exceed the simplified acquisition threshold, currently USD 250,000 as per FAR 2.101. Furthermore, as per FAR 52.212-3 “The Offeror shall complete only paragraph (b) of this provision if the Offeror has completed the annual representations and certification electronically in the System for Award Management (SAM) accessed through <https://www.sam.gov>”. All prospective bidders/offeror are **REQUIRED** to register into SAM database prior submission of their quotes. The contractor shall provide required information and documentation required by FAR 52.212-3(h) if requested by Contracting Officer. Failure to provide documents upon receiving such request by CO shall lead to termination of awarded contract.
